

Schilling STEM Scholarship

Amount: Up to \$5,000 (\$2,500 Fall; \$2,500 Spring) per academic year

I. Purpose

The Schilling STEM Scholarship provides financial support to University of North Florida students pursuing degrees in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics (STEM).

II. Criteria

- Meet UNF admission requirements and be accepted to the University of North Florida.
- Be enrolled full-time in a STEM major.
- Enroll in at least 12 credit hours during Fall and Spring semesters.
- Have a minimum 3.3 high school or transfer GPA.
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.3.
- Be a Florida resident for tuition purposes.
- Be a U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident.
- Complete the FAFSA.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Awards are based on merit, with highest GPAs receiving priority.

Recipient Responsibilities

- Maintain full-time enrollment (12+ credits in Fall and Spring).
- Earn at least 24 credits each academic year.
- Maintain a 3.3 cumulative GPA.
- Submit a FAFSA annually.
- Comply with all university policies and conduct standards.
- Authorize release of academic information for donor reporting.
- Remain in good academic standing.

Renewal Requirements

Current recipients may receive priority consideration for renewal if funding is available and all scholarship requirements continue to be met. Students may receive no more than eight semesters of scholarship support.

Students are automatically considered for this award upon acceptance-no separate application is necessary.
