Subject: Draft 2025-2035 Campus Master Plan Presentation

Recommended Action:

No action required. First public hearing, draft presentation to the Board, and start of the 90-day agency review.

Background Information:

As required by Florida Statutes, the University is updating the Campus Master Plan. The plan is the physical embodiment of the University strategic plan and addresses the needs related to future land use, transportation, capital improvements, recreation and open space, general infrastructure, housing, and conservation for the next 10 years and beyond. Over the last year, the DLR Group has held listening sessions, focus groups and informal public meetings to solicit input and develop the plan. This presentation and public hearing of the draft master plan is required before the plan is sent out for the required 90-day agency review. The final plan will be brought to the Board of Trustees for adoption later this year.
