

Comparison of Admission and Program Requirements

Please read carefully to determine to which program, how to apply, and the requirements of each program.

MS/Dietetic Internship Program

Application Process

- Two submission sites:
- Submit through DICAS/complete the DICAS matching process, which requires
 - Internship application
 - Three reference letters
 - Personal statement
 - DPD Verification Form or Intent to complete form,
 - Official GRE scores
 - Official transcripts with GPA using the DICAS and D&D* application process
- Submit through UNF Graduate School – Online Application Process
 - MS/DI application
 - Graduate application fees
- MS/DI participants will be UNF students.

MS/DI Student Program of Study

- Upon acceptance drug testing, finger printing, criminal background check and immunization required.
- 1200 hours of Supervised Practice Experiences in Florida region or other areas
- 12-15 graduate course
- credits per regular (12 or 16 week) semester via
- Distance Learning
- Occasional additional service-learning activities

Note: Students **are** eligible for student grants or loans

ISPP – Individualized Supervised Practice Pathway

Application Process

- Submit through UNF ISPP application process, which requires
 - Completed ISPP application form
 - Three reference letters
 - Personal statement
 - Evidence of –match/non- acceptance to an ACEND internship via D&D Matching system (unless already have a doctoral degree)
 - DPD Verification form (unless already have a doctoral degree)
 - Official GRE scores (unless already have a doctoral degree)
 - Official transcripts with GPA Vita with years of work experience
- ISPP participants will not be **UNF students** but are participating in a specific verification producing program.

ISPP Candidate Program of Study

- Upon acceptance drug testing, finger printing and criminal background required.
- Initial assessment of candidate education and experiences for determination of hours needed for competency completion
- Candidates **MUST** find their own preceptors for supervised practice prior to acceptance
- Supervised practice will take place in **various locations** based on identified preceptors
- Some states have restrictions on supervised practice, so the ISPP cannot be done in those states.

- No graduate coursework required.

MS Online Non-Internship Program

Application Process

- Submit through UNF Graduate School – Online Application Process
- Applicants interested in Professional Studies in Dietetics must have a baccalaureate degree in nutrition from an ACEND accredited program or a verification statement from an ACEND accredited program.
- Applicants interested in Nutrition Science, Global Health or Health Informatics concentrations must have a baccalaureate degree in nutrition or a related area from a regionally accredited
- U.S. institution or its equivalent from a foreign institution.
- All applications must have a GPA of a 3.0 or higher in all work attempted in the last 60 credit hours of undergraduate study
- Official GRE scores or proof of a minimum of 3 years of professional experience in nutrition and dietetics
- Official transcripts with GPA
- Letter of Intent
