

Careers with a Master's in English

In 2012, The National Association of Colleges and Employers estimated that those holding a master's degree in English earn 20.1% more than those holding a bachelor's degree.

A Master's in English prepares you to teach at the following levels:

- High school English, dual enrollment
- Four-year colleges

The degree prepares you for the following kinds of writing/editing positions:

- Technical writing (for businesses, web-based companies such as Web.com)
- Public relations
- Marketing
- Grant writing for non-profits and government agencies
- Magazine writing and editing
- Publishing

The degree prepares you for the following advanced educational opportunities:

- Doctoral programs in composition, rhetoric, literature, and film
- Law school
