

UNF Summer Music Camp Rules and Regulations

1. Students are expected to attend ALL scheduled classes, rehearsals, and concerts. Attendance will be taken. You must notify a camp counselor if you are too sick to attend class. Habitual tardiness or missed classes will result in being asked to leave camp.
2. No student will be allowed to operate a motor vehicle during the course of the camp.
3. While in the Residence Hall, students are under the supervision of the counseling staff and are expected to abide by their decisions. Rudeness and disrespect will not be tolerated.
4. The use of alcoholic beverages, narcotics, or tobacco is strictly prohibited. The use or possession is cause for immediate dismissal. Parents will be called to pick up offending students.
5. Students will not be allowed to leave campus at any time during the camp. Exceptions will be made for campers wishing to leave with their parents for a meal. Counselors must be notified of this. Each student will have a counselor that they are assigned to for such reporting.
6. Students are expected to be in their rooms by curfew time and abide by lights-out rules set by the Camp Director and counselors.
7. Residence Hall furniture is not to be moved.
8. Cell phones should not be used during classes or concerts. Better yet, leave your cell phone in your RH room during the day. Violators will have their phones confiscated for the remainder of the day.

MEALS

Campers will be issued a name tag upon arrival. You must wear this tag at all times. It is also used as a meal card - you must wear it in order to eat. No refunds will be issued to campers who do not use all of their allotted meals. When students finish eating, they are to remain with counselors at the Café or request to return to the Fine Arts Center with a counselor.

AUTO REGULATIONS

Camp members may NOT operate automobiles while attending the Camp. If personally driven autos are essential in order to provide transportation to and from the camp (high school seniors only), these vehicles MUST be registered with the camp office, parked in

the designated area with an official UNF parking permit (furnished by the camp office when the auto is registered).

THE CAMP WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PARKING TICKETS RECEIVED IF AUTOS ARE NOT PARKED IN THE DESIGNATED AREAS AS SHOWN ON THE PARKING PERMITS.

Parents attending the Friday concert must purchase a \$5 parking pass for their vehicle. Failure to do so will result in a parking ticket.

SECURITY

Small instruments, such as flutes and clarinets, will be kept by each student or can be stored in small lockers in the instrument storage room. All larger instruments will be stored in the instrument storage room or taken back to Residence Hall rooms daily. Students may bring their own locks to use these lockers.

BE SURE YOU HAVE YOUR INSTRUMENTS LABELED WITH YOUR NAME AND ADDRESS.

Overnight campers will each have a key to their own Residence Hall room, and rooms MUST be kept locked at all times. A refundable \$20 deposit will be collected and check-in for keys.

IF YOU WISH TO USE A DEPARTMENT OF MUSIC LOCKER, YOU MUST BRING YOUR OWN LOCK. NEVER LEAVE YOUR INSTRUMENT OR OTHER PERSONAL BELONGS UNATTENDED. WE CANNOT BE RESPONSIBLE IF PERSONAL ITEMS ARE STOLEN OR LOST DUE TO NEGLIGENCE. UNF DOES NOT HAVE INSURANCE TO COVER STOLEN INSTRUMENTS.
