



## **\$1,500.00 Scholarship for Physics Majors!**

### **THE CAROLYN AND KENNETH SHACTER SCHOLARSHIP**

*Application deadline: Friday, April 9, 2021*

The Department of Physics is pleased to offer a \$1,500 scholarship to support students pursuing a degree in Physics during the 2021/2022 academic year. This scholarship was endowed by Carolyn and Kenneth Shacter.

To be eligible a student must –

- Meet admissions requirements and be accepted to the University of North Florida;
- Reside in Florida for tuition purposes;
- Earn a minimum cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0, and
- Declare a major in physics.

Students awarded this scholarship must also agree to:

- Enroll full-time (12 credit hours) each semester and earn a minimum of 24 credits by the end of each academic year;
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0;
- Comply with all University regulations, rules, and codes of conduct governing students on campus;
- Consent to release grades to the Division of Institutional Advancement for the purpose of reporting to the Donors; and
- Remain in good standing as a student.

Current recipients may apply for renewal and may be given preference pending availability of funding, and if *all of the preceding requirements have been met*. Scholarship applications must now be submitted online via Academic Works. Students should have received an email notification to opt-in Academic Works.
