- Reside in Florida for tuition purposes
- Enroll full-time with at least 12 semester hours each semester (Fall 2018 & Spring 2019)
- Be selected by a committee chosen by PSPA dept. of the College of Arts and Sciences.

**Students awarded this scholarship must also agree to:**

- Enroll full-time each semester and earn a minimum of 24 credits by the end of each academic year
- Comply with all University regulations, rules, codes of conduct governing students on campus
- Maintain a GPA of at least 3.0 for the junior and senior years
- Consent to release grades to the Division of Development and Alumni Affairs for the purpose of reporting to the donor
- Remain in good standing order as a student
