If a student holds a baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited U.S. institution, or its equivalent from a foreign institution, with a GPA of 3.0 or higher in all work attempted in the last 60 credit hours of undergraduate study — **he or she does not need to take the GRE.**

Higher Education Administration ELECTIVE TRACKS

Students can customize this degree to fit their personal goals by choosing one of three elective tracks.

General Higher Education Track

For students interested in administrative careers throughout the university. These can include, but are not limited to: academic advising, enrollment services, development and alumni affairs, finance and administration, graduate studies, technology.

Student Affairs Track

For students interested in careers in student life. These can include, but are not limited to: residence life, campus activities, Greek life, career services, student conduct and judicial affairs, campus recreation, diversity and cultural inclusion.

International Higher Education

For students interested in careers directing or coordinating study abroad programs, international student recruitment, international student programming. Students earning the international higher education track are also prepared for careers at international universities or with third party study abroad providers.
