This schedule has been designed to provide some guidance for you to assist in course planning. We have actually been offering the required courses on this schedule for several years, but realize that having a posted schedule will make this more convenient for all. Please note that this schedule is currently for Required (Core/Major Courses) only. We are now attempting to create a master schedule for electives, but that is harder to do as often these classes depend on the availability of specific instructors, demand, etc. All Fall/Spring courses are offered 6:00 PM to 8:45 PM.

*This course is taught every term for all master's students in the college and may be taken anytime. The Spring Thursday section has been specifically scheduled around the class & work schedules of HEA students and usually has a more "HEA-focused" instructor.

Recommended Course Sequence:

The HEA program has been designed as a non-cohort, rolling admission program, meaning that students can begin any term and take as many, or as few, courses a term as they wish. The following schedules are merely “suggested” based on the most typical patterns of full and part-time students. However, they do not reflect a required schedule and students are free to take all courses (except those with pre-requisites) in any order they wish to. For example, students beginning in Spring or Summer can simply start with that Year One suggestion and move forward.

It is also important to note that the HEA program never offers required courses in Summer term, only electives.
