Earn more than a new passport stamp...

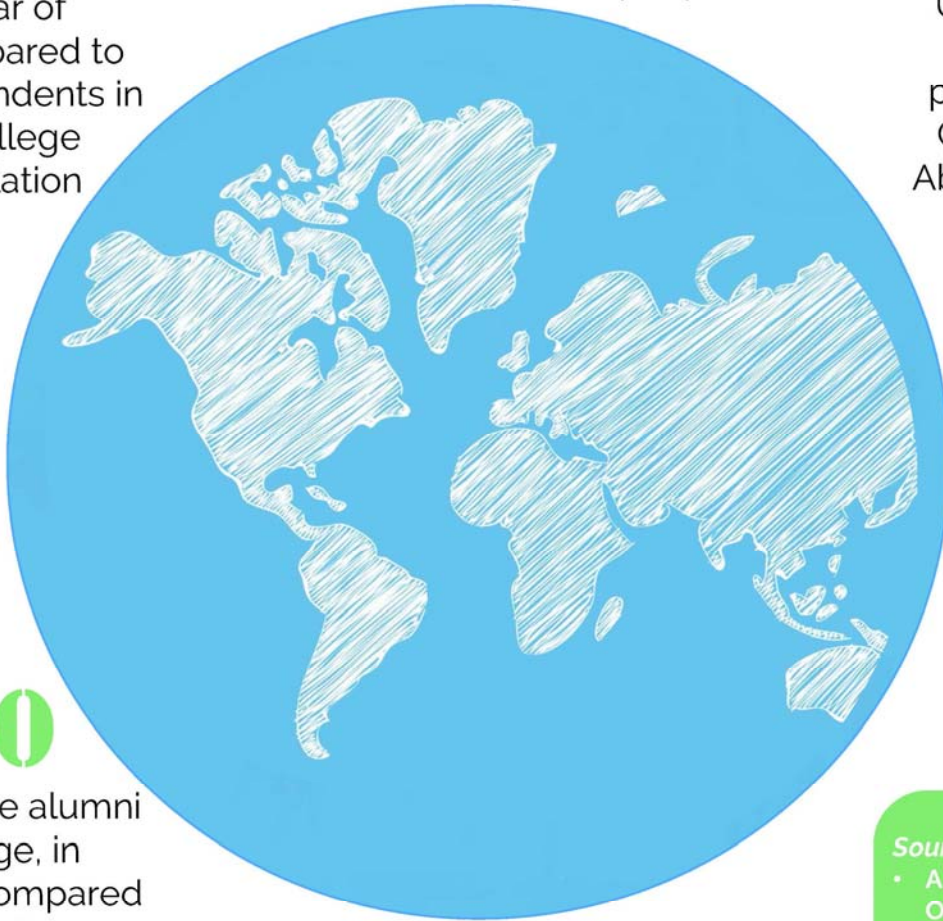
97%
