Essay Section

Tips: In completing essays for any application (job, scholarship, this one), it is **very important** to address the qualities being asked about. Your application is reviewed by the Honors committee and poorly answered questions tend to get applicants rejected.

Writing a too-short response feels like you didn't give a thoughtful answer (or don't have anything to add). Writing unclearly and with fluff feels like you're just trying to fill the space. Avoid these. Be complete but concise and tell us, with examples where logical, why you have what we're looking for.

Describe your “well roundedness” through extracurricular activities showing your interests in more than one area. The Honors programs seek students who are multi-faceted, not just highly qualified in a single dimension. (100 words or fewer.)

Describe what experience or motivation led you to major in marketing and of how you expect to contribute to the program and to the company offering you an internship. Respond by thinking of the needs of others and what you can add. The Honors programs seek students who are clearly interested in the field of marketing. (400 words or fewer.)

Thinking about the topics covered in principles of marketing (or other marketing classes), describe your ideal marketing job and the industry it would be in (e.g., banking, manufacturing, retail, etc.—or a specific company if you have one in mind).
To be clear, we are looking for you to describe a specific area of marketing and, optionally, an industry you are currently interested in. (100 words or fewer.)

Please provide any other helpful information you think the Honors Committee should know about you. Here give us anything you think would be helpful in knowing more about you. (100 words or fewer.)
