ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Master's degree in nursing from a regionally accredited institution and program accredited by the NLNAC or CCNE
- Active national certification in one of the following APRN roles: NE-BC, NEA-BC, CNM, CNS, CRNA, or NP (copy of actual certificate is required). Certification waives 3 credit hours of the 9 required residency hours. CRNA waives an additional 3 credit hours of residency
- Minimum graduate GPA of 3.30
- Current licensure as a registered nurse or advanced practice registered nurse in the candidate's state of practice (copy of actual licensure is required)
- Current resume or curriculum vitae
- Two (2) letters of reference — one professional and one academic — which address clinical skills and academic ability
