

# you've been admitted NOW WHAT?

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## Check your UNF email

Now that you're admitted, we will only correspond with you via your official [UNF email](#) account. It is essential that you set up your account and check it frequently for important messages. You are responsible for checking your UNF email on a regular basis, and acting on time sensitive requests starting now. In fact, you may have a message already waiting for you!

## Clear holds

Once admitted, you will receive holds that will need to be cleared before you can register for courses. It is important to begin the process as soon as possible to avoid delays in registration that may result in late fees.

- To access your holds, visit your [myWings](#) account, and click on the *Hold's* tile.
- At the bottom of the list that populates, click on Learn How to Remove Holds. This will take you to a screen where you can view who to contact to remove the hold.
- Holds that are hyperlinked can be removed by clicking on them and completing the requested action.
- Please note, some holds take 24 hours to clear once the requested action has been completed.

## Register for classes

You will register for classes according to your registration time ticket in [myWings](#). Registration information is available on the [Records and Registration website](#).

## Complete a FAFSA

## Pay tuition and fees

Payments for tuition must be received by [Student Financial Services](#) by the published payment deadline to be considered on time. Postmarks are not accepted. Payments placed in the drop box after the close of business will be assessed a \$100 late payment fee.

## Submit official documents

If you were admitted with unofficial or incomplete transcripts or test scores, your admission is contingent upon the receipt of the final official copies of these documents. All documentation must be received by the UNF Graduate School during your first term of enrollment. Failure to provide required documentation will result in a registration hold preventing future term registration.
