 - Graduate enrollment = **9.82%** of UNF FTE (10,379)

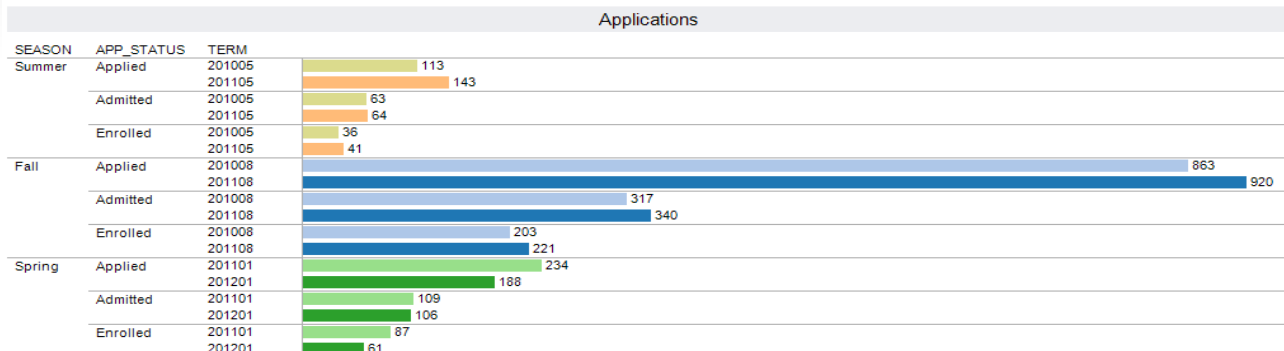
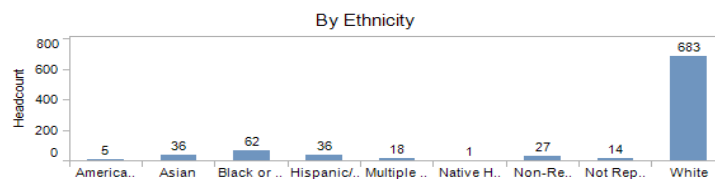
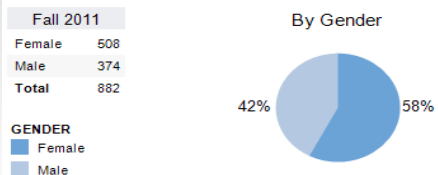
