

Research Graduate Faculty

Criteria:

- Terminal degree in teaching discipline
- Tenure-track or research professor line
- Evidence of significant and continuing scholarship and/or creative activity
- Evidence of teaching competency at the graduate level

Privileges:

- Teach graduate courses
- Serve on graduate student exam/thesis/dissertation committees
- Serve as graduate program director
- Participate on Graduate Council

Appointments:

- Assistant and associate professors reviewed every 5 years; full professors reviewed every 10 years

Teaching Graduate Faculty

Criteria:

- Terminal degree, or equivalent education and/or experience, in discipline
- Continuing faculty position (i.e., not adjuncts or visitors)
- Evidence of continuing scholarship, creative activity, and/or relevant clinical practice
- Evidence of teaching competency at the graduate level

Privileges:

- Teach specified clinical/professional graduate courses
- Can only serve on student exam/thesis/dissertation committees through an exception or as an additional member beyond the minimum required committee membership

Appointments:

- Reviewed every 3 years
