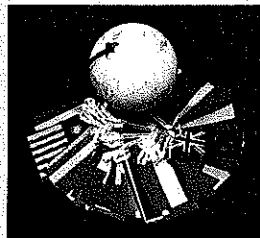

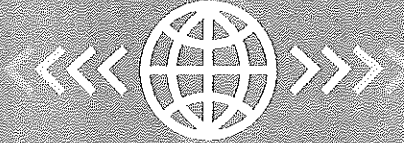

#### **Considerations**

- When developing a new program or modifying an existing one, consider there are issues with online courses.
- New programs may need additional approval.
- International students must be enrolled full-time (Fall & Spring). Summer is optional, except if it is the initial semester.

According to NAFSA, in 2015, international students contributed:

- **\$32.8 billion** to the **U.S. economy**
- **\$1.3 billion** to the **Florida economy**
