

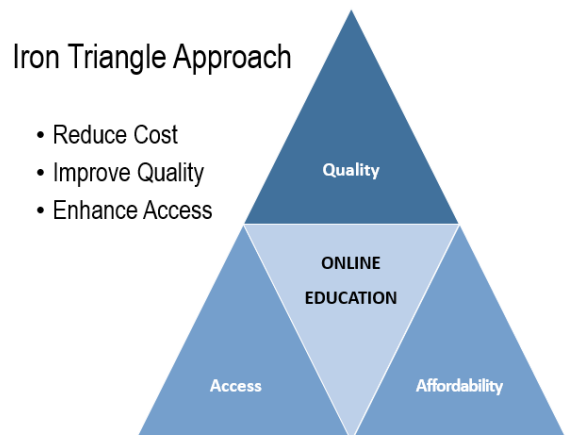

Development of the Strategic Plan

- 2012 Postsecondary Online Expansion in Florida and its Detailed Fact Base
- 2013 Task Force for Postsecondary Online Education in Florida
- 2014-15 Task Force for Strategic Planning was created
- 5 SUS presidents, 4 provosts, Faculty, Students, Complete Florida/Florida Virtual Campus, FCS Council of Presidents
 - Focus on iron triangle - quality, access & affordability
 - Solicited review and feedback from statewide groups (CAVP, Council of Student Affairs, Council of Administrative & Financial Affairs, FLVC MCDLSS, FCS COP, Advisory Council of Faculty Senates & governmental relations staff)
 - Unanimous approval of the plan by the BOG Innovation & Online Cmte and the BOG

2025 Strategic Plan for Online Education Brief Overview

- A framework to provide more Florida citizens with educational credentials;

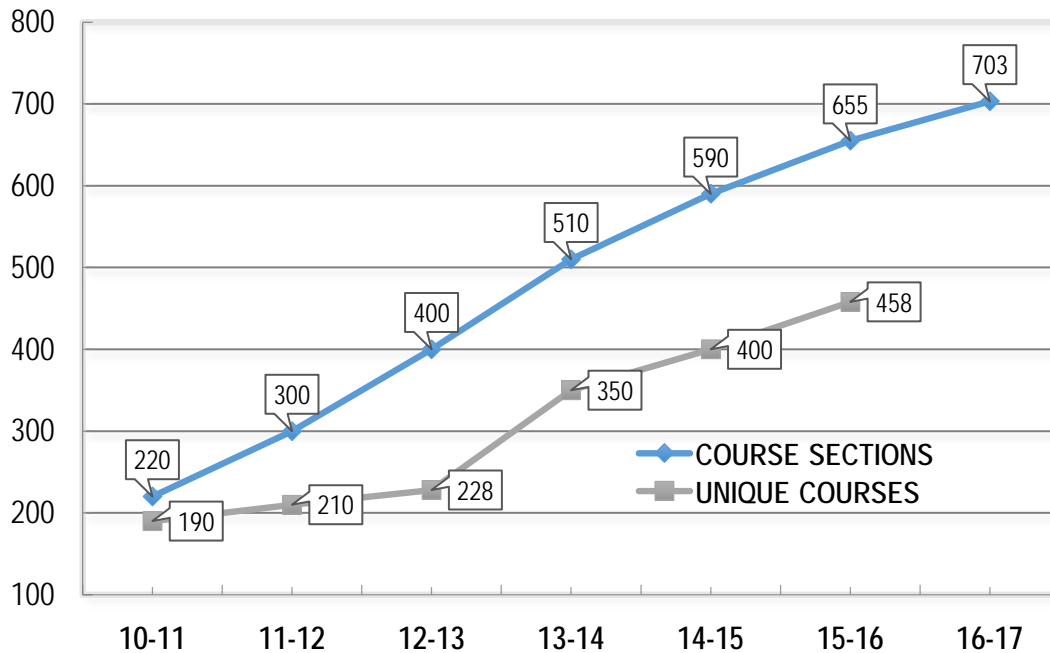
